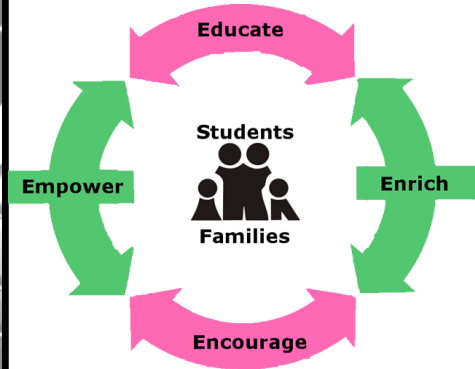


## Who We Are

## Parents & Families

- ◆ Providing interventions to reduce family stress
